Kennel Room/Ward Cleaning Recommended every 30 days

- Remove gross contamination, discard waste into lidded container identified as General Waste.
- 2. A **detergent** solution such as Sunlight, or Ivory should be used to clean every surface by spraying and scrubbing room, contents and floor
 - a. Outside of kennel(s), walls, counters, cabinets, floors, food bowls etc.
 - b. It is crucial that the detergent be used to first, clean the ward and remove organic waste.
- 3. Rinse and allow to dry. If this is not at all possible, you must squeegee the room and remove as much surface water as possible.
- 4. Every surface must be sprayed with (disinfectant and strength) and soaked for appropriate contact time according to manufacturer's instructions (manufacturer recommended contact time).
 - a. Kennel, walls, counters, cabinets, floors, food bowls etc.
- 5. Remove waste bag to disposal area for general hospital waste.
- 6. Keep a log of when this cleaning is performed to keep on track with recommended cleaning time.
